This spring travel course offered every other year fulfills the Citizenship graduation requirement and includes spending 10 days in late May in Brazil. Students travel to Natal, Brazil and take classes at the Federal University of Rio Grande do Norte in elementary Portuguese and the history of Brazil. Then the group will participate in two days of service in two poverty-stricken neighborhoods in Natal before traveling to the interior of the state of Rio Grande do Norte for two additional days of service in the town of Currais Novos. Following completion of the service projects, students will travel to Ponta Negra, a seaside town, for debriefing and relaxation. Students are encouraged to apply for travel scholarships in the Global Education Office.
