Travel to Brazil to examine the relationship among gender, sexuality, and sport in Latin America. Students spend eight days in Rio de Janeiro engaged in a service learning project in partnership with the UN Women's program to promote sport among school-aged girls in Latin America. Students will participate in a variety of activities with local Brazilian students, including leading a sport activity and attending a gender workshop, and they will write in a reflective journal throughout their trip. Students will also have opportunities to learn basics of the Portuguese language and explore Brazilian cultural sites around the Rio area. The course also counts towards the Women and Gender Studies minor.

Students are encouraged to apply for travel scholarships in the Global Education Office.
