GoodGuidesTM FACT SHEET

- The Goodwill GoodGuidesTM youth mentoring program is a national initiative funded by a grant through the U.S. Department of Justice.
- ❖ GoodGuides[™] has been established at 56 Goodwills across the nation.
- ❖ GoodGuidesTM will help youth, ages 13-17, prepare for school completion, develop work skills, identify career paths and transition to post-secondary opportunities over a 1 year period.
- Goodwill Industries of Northern New England (GINNE) has established the GoodGuidesTM program in Claremont, NH, Springfield, VT and Portland, ME.
- Mentors work with teens four hours each month on homework, job applications, resume writing, job interviews, and other tasks as needed.
- Research shows that mentoring promotes positive outcomes with, youth including increased academic performance, improved self-esteem, and better careers while reducing school failure, the use and abuse of illegal substances, and youth delinquency.
