#### Travel Course Policies

- Valid passport is required for travel. A student may apply for the course while in the process of applying for a passport, but must have a passport in time for travel. A copy of your passport photo page must be provided to the Global Education Program at least two weeks prior to traveling.
- Travel costs are billed to students as a lab fee. After December 9, 2016 the travel fees are non-refundable.
- Travel medical insurance is included for participants in UNE travel courses for the duration of the course only. Students planning to travel on their own before or after the course are responsible for their own medical insurance during that time.
- Students on UNE travel programs are expected to abide by University policies and to participate fully and be engaged in the academic experience. The UNE faculty member and/or host institution may dismiss a student for inappropriate conduct, disruption of the program, or posing a threat to him/herself or other students. In such cases, the student will incur the expenses related to dismissal.
