Dear Residency Candidate,

The University of New England College of Pharmacy is seeking applicants for a PGY1 pharmacy practice residency, with an emphasis in community care. Our program has recently been granted precandidate status by the Accreditation Services Division from the American Society of Health-Systems Pharmacists. One residency position is available for the 2013-14 year. The residency program activities include direct patient care services, teaching, practice management and scholarly activity.

The residency is program is designed such that 60% of the resident's time will be dedicated to patient care services, 20% of teaching, 10% to practice management and 10% to scholarly activity.

The resident will be exposed to five longitudinal and three concentrated learning experiences through their year of tenure. The main longitudinal experiences revolve around practice management and patient care services. The concentrated learning experiences comprise both didactic and experiential teaching. In addition, the resident may choose concentrated electives as part of their residency experience.

Applications received by January 15, 2013 will be assured of full consideration. On-site interviews will be offered to qualified candidates in the months of January and February.
