UNDERGRADUATE SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION FOR THE 2005/2006 ACADEMIC YEAR

Eligibility Requirements

- 1. Applicant must apply to become a member of NATA not later than November 1, 2004.
- 2. Applicant must have a cumulative overall GPA of at least 3.2 (based on a 4.0 maximum) for ALL undergraduate courses to date (minimum of 5 semesters or 7 quarters), to include the Fall of **2004**.
- 3. Applicant must be enrolled in an undergraduate program requiring four years for a baccalaureate degree, and may apply during his/her junior year, or immediately prior to his/her final undergraduate academic year (provided that the submission/postmark date requirement is met).
- 4. Applicant must have performed with distinction as a participant in his/her athletic training program, academic major, institution, intercollegiate athletics and American higher education.
- 5. Applicant must confirm his/her intent to pursue the athletic training profession as his/her primary means of livelihood.

Application Instructions

- 1. All sections of the application packet must be fully completed and signed as directed.
 - Section I General Information (to be completed and signed by the applicant)
 - Section II Nomination Form (to be completed and signed by a NATABOC certified athletic trainer, who can attest to the applicant's skills, abilities and scholarly activities as they relate to this application)
 - <u>Section III</u> *Institutional Endorsement* (to be completed and signed by the dean of the college or the department head responsible for the applicant's academic program)
 - Section IV Applicant's Essay (to be written and signed by the applicant)
- 2. All information in the application packet (other than signatures) must be typed.
- 3. Application packets must include official transcripts of ALL undergraduate course work to date, to include the Fall of **2004**. Incomplete application packets will not be processed.
- 4. A fully completed application packet, and ALL academic transcripts, must be mailed to the NATA Foundation; 2952 Stemmons; Dallas, TX 75247, and postmarked not later than February 10, **2005**.

Evaluation and Award Process

- 1. All NATA Foundation scholarships are for \$2,000.
- 2. Need shall not be a factor in granting NATA Foundation scholarships. Assistance from other sources will not make the applicant ineligible for a NATA Foundation scholarship.
- 3. Consideration will be given to the applicant's participation in campus activities other than academic and athletic training, in which he/she has demonstrated qualities of leadership and has been a positive example to fellow students.
- 4. Applicants will be notified of the Scholarship Committee's decision by April 15, 2005.
- 5. Once a scholarship has been awarded to an individual, he/she is no longer eligible for a scholarship in the same category. The current categories available are Undergraduate, Masters and Doctoral.
- 6. The selected applicant must provide proof of enrollment in an accredited **undergraduate** program for the **2005/2006** academic year before a check will be issued, and is expected to remain enrolled as a full time student in an accredited **undergraduate** program. NOTE: An exception may be granted if the recipient is assigned to active military service or due to other extenuating circumstances acceptable to the NATA Foundation Scholarship Committee.
