This fall travel course fulfills the Citizenship graduation requirement and includes travel in early January to Cusco, Peru, the royal city of the former Inca Empire. Students are immersed in Spanish language and Peruvian culture at a private school, stay with local host families, and engage in hands-on health care volunteer work in clinics, including a two-day health care campaign in an indigenous village. The course also includes a city tour of Cusco, a museum visit of the Hiram Bingham Machu Picchu collection, visits to Pisaq, Moray and the Chinchero weaving cooperative in the Sacred Valley, and finally a guided tour of the "lost city" of Machu Picchu.
