Student FTE is calculated using headcount method: The full-time equivalent of the institution's part-time enrollment is estimated by multiplying all part-time students by 1/3. These are then added to the full-time enrollment headcounts to obtain an FTE for all students enrolled in the spring. Office of Institutional Research and Assessment
