Summer Program in Tangier, Morocco University of New England Tangier Campus

July 9–August 21, 2016

Spend the summer in beautiful Tangier! The University of New England Tangier Campus is within easy access to downtown, beaches, and the major cultural activities the city has to offer. Choose from courses, taught in English, in the lab sciences, humanities and Arabic language. Students live at the on-campus residence and meals are served at the onsite café. The Tangier Campus staff also organizes group excursions and activities as part of the program.

Program includes:

- 6-9 credits with official transcript issued by the University of New England
- Onsite orientation activities
- Support of Tangier Campus staff
- Airport pick-up upon arrival in Tangier
- Double occupancy room with en-suite bathroom at on-campus residence
- Meals at on-campus café
- Group excursions to other cities in Morocco and activities in and around Tangier
- Opportunity to volunteer with local organizations

Program fee:

\$330 per credit plus \$2,000 for room and board

Important:

- A minimum 2.5 GPA is required.
- Students must have a valid passport before traveling.
- Airfare to/from Tangier is not included.
