Henry Goddard Thomas was born in Maine. He graduated from Amherst College in 1858 and entered the Civil War as a private, rising through the ranks to reach brigadier general by war's end. He was involved with the recruitment and organization of Negro troops in the Union army. Thomas retired in 1891 and died in 1897.
