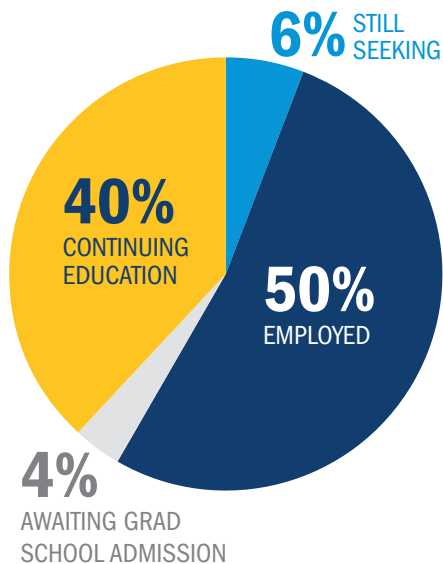

DESTINATION BY CATEGORY



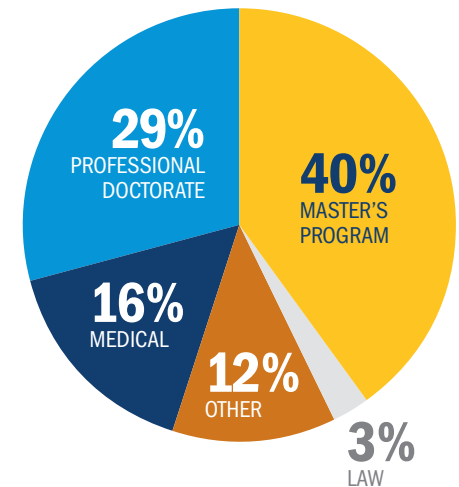
