A multidisciplinary minor is a structured plan of study outside the student's major. Students also design a multidisciplinary minor in thematic areas such as: Peace Studies, or International Studies. Such programs would require a proposed plan of study approved by the CAS and/or WCHP Academic Dean and a faculty sponsor. The minimum number of credits required for a minor is 18 credits. Minors will not be confused with personal majors, concentrations within majors, or directed studies.
