

We are committed to academic excellence and will provide the tools and environment that support it and measure progress toward achievement and continuous improvement. We will link resources across colleges and administrative units to integrate and advance academic programs to a level of national recognition.

Targeted Goal: UNE will establish a Center for Teaching, Learning, and Technology

With almost immediate access to a universe of knowledge, students must learn to qualify and synthesize information efficiently and effectively.

The Center will be a resource for information and preparation of faculty in advanced and innovative instructional programs utilizing technology for enhanced teaching and learning results. Undergraduate and graduate education will be improved through the Center's focus on the art of teaching and the process of learning.

Targeted Goal: UNE will establish an integrated Center for Academic Health Sciences

With a College of Health Professions, a College of Osteopathic Medicine, and a new College of Pharmacy, UNE is already well known for its programs in medicine and the health professions. The Center will foster interdisciplinary education and clinical practice by implementing successful models for integrating existing and emerging health science education programs with research and service.

With the pace of discovery and the body of knowledge increasing exponentially, research and scholarship are crucial to a learning-centered environment. We will support our faculty by establishing university-wide development programs to enhance and encourage research and scholarship. Our professors will foster mentoring of undergraduate and graduate students through creative and interdisciplinary research opportunities.

Targeted Goal: UNE will establish four Centers of Research and Scholarship. We will improve resources and establish policies that enable us to create interdisciplinary centers of research and scholarship excellence with focus

areas of national recognition. Researchers will work in collaboration with educators, scholars, clinicians, patients, government agencies, and private companies to address complex societal problems and to find solutions together, with the Centers providing a matrix for coordination of ideas and support.

HISTORY OF UNIVERSITY OF NEW ENGLAND

The University of New England is a top-ranked independent, coeducational university with two distinctive campuses located in the coastal communities of Biddeford and Portland, Maine. It has over 4,000 students and offers more than 40 undergraduate, graduate and professional degree programs. The institution is the leading provider of healthcare professionals in the state of Maine, and has recognized strengths in osteopathic medicine; health sciences; biological, marine, and environmental sciences; and other select areas of excellence in the liberal arts.

The institution upholds the proud traditions and spirit of the original colleges that merged to become the University of New England. St. Francis College traces its commitment to

liberal arts and science education to its founding by the Franciscan order in 1939. The New England College of Osteopathic Medicine was established in 1978 with a mission of training osteopathic physicians who would practice primary care medicine. The two colleges successfully joined to establish the University of New England. In 1996 the University merged with Westbrook College, an institution that has promoted higher education opportunities for men and women since it was founded in 1831. The College of Health Professions was established on the Portland Campus in 2001, and renamed the Westbrook College of Health Professions in 2008 in recognition of its heritage. The University's fourth college, the College of Pharmacy, was established on the Portland Campus in 2007.
