



**Things you should pack...**

Bedspread	Shower Shoes/Flip Flops
Blanket	Radio/Stereo
Sheets (extra long twin)	Television
Pillow	Microwave
Alarm clock	Small Refrigerator
Waste basket ( <b>metal only</b> )	Iron
Fan	Non-Halogen Reading Lamp

Toiletries	*Flame retardant curtains/Wall hangings

\*During move-in day and the weeks after, students will be able to have their curtains treated (wall hangings, tapestries, etc...) to guarantee the curtains are flame retardant. Once the item(s) have been treated, the student will be able to hang them. Staff will tag and keep a record of the treated items for future Health and Safety Inspections.

**Things that should remain home...**

Hot plate	Air conditioners
Candles (with or without wicks)	Space Heaters
Firearms and fireworks	Incense, Tart, Popourri, or Oil burners
Knives and blades	Products containing bleach
Halogen lamps	

Pets (**Fish, fresh water turtles, and aquatic frogs** are the only pets allowed in the residence halls. Aquariums are restricted to one 20-gallon tank per student.)

\*\*Toaster ovens, and items with an open heating element may not be used any residence hall rooms (**Assisi, Avila, Champlain, East, Featherman, Frederick, Padua, Siena, and West Halls**); there are kitchens available in each residence hall for cooking.
