REQUIRED DISCLOSURE SLIDES AS PART OF PRESENTATIONS

Prior to beginning a session, presenters will be asked to disclose any relationship they may have with companies providing drugs, medical equipment, services etc. that may have relevance to the content of their presentations. Such disclosure is intended to provide participants with sufficient information to evaluate whether any given presentation has been influenced by the presenters' relationship(s) or financial interest(s) with said companies. *This procedure does not replace paper or electronic signed Disclosure Statements.*

This is in accordance to the ACCME Policy Guidelines on Written Agreement for Commercial Support disclosure must be disclosed to the participants, in program brochures, syllabi, and other program materials, and at the time of the activity – of which the inclusion of the powerpoint slide is most appropriate.

PLACEMENT IN PRESENTATION: FIRST SLIDE AFTER TITLE SLIDE - BEFORE BEGINNING ACTUAL PRESENTATION

SAMPLE LANGUAGE:
