## Notes:

- 1. Includes only students enrolled for credit. Excludes students exclusively auditing classes and students studying abroad (i.e., at another university).
- 2. Per IPEDS/NCES directive, DPT, DPTP, Pharm D, DMD and DO degrees will be reported as Doctor's Degree Professional Practice
- 3. In Fall 2015, there is a large increase in non-degree undergraduates from the numbers reported in prior term census reports due to a change that more accurately captures students enrolled in a non-degree pre-health course on the October 15th date.

### Definitions

New: First term at UNE at that level. Returning: Continuing at UNE

**FTE** = Full time equivalent: This is equal to the headcount of full-time students plus the total credit hours earned by part-time students divided by the normal credit hour load for a full-time student. UNE uses the following definitions for full-time loads:

Undergraduate full-time load: 12 or more credit hours per semester.

Master's, Certificate, Post Bac, Post Master's, & Ed.D. full-time load: 6 or more crd hrs per semester.

MSNA, MSPA, MOT, DPT, DO, PharmD & DMD students are full-time regardless of the number of credits.
