A Maine native, Frances Emery-Waterhouse spent years in Guatemala where her husband grew bananas. She learned Spanish and wrote for local newspapers and magazines. She published *Banana paradise* in 1947 and composed numerous songs about Central America. Upon her return to Maine, she continued to write articles for local newspapers and compose songs. She died in 1966.
