Title: Freshmen Profile Trends

Description: This report tracks applications, admitted, and enrolled new freshmen at UNE each fall semester. The report also highlights some academic averages and demographic details for new freshmen enrolled at census each fall.

Purpose: To show trends in new first-time freshmen at UNE.

## Implications:

1. UNE received the highest number of applications in the 10-year report period in fall 2019. This represents a 56.1\% increase since fall 2009.
2. Percentage of applicants who were admitted increased in fall 2019 to $84.4 \%$, the highest percentage since fall 2015.
3. Percentage of students who are first-generation (based on data provided on the FAFSA) has declined 8.3 percentage points over ten years which encompasses a $19.7 \%$ decrease in firstgeneration enrollment for first-time freshmen; however, fall 2019 first-generation enrollment increased to the highest rate since fall 2015 at 18.3\%.
4. High school GPA trended up in the ten year report period, going from 3.2 in fall 2009 to 3.37 in fall 2019.
