Breakfast at hotel. Tour the Vatican Museums with a local guide. In the late afternoon, visit the Capuchin Crypt (ossuary) beneath Santa Maria della Concezione. Dinner in Rome. Evening visit to the Trevi Fountain. Overnight at hotel in Rome.

DAY 7 | Florence

Breakfast at hotel. In the morning, visit the Galleria Borghese in Rome. Afternoon train to Florence. Dinner; overnight at hotel in Florence.
