## ACADEMIC PROGRAM REVIEW SCHEDULE

*Updated September 2025*

---

At the University of New England, academic programs are regularly reviewed for quality assurance.

The regular program review process comprises three tracks. (1) Programs with specialized accreditation undertake a review the semester following their full reaccreditation review. (2) Programs without specialized accreditation undertake a review following a seven-year cycle. (3) Programs with specialized accreditation that undergo a reaccreditation review every eight or more years also complete an internal review at the midpoint of their full reaccreditation review.

Newly developed programs undergo a three-year new program review following their third year in the catalog.
