## **PROGRAM UPDATES**

We have been working in collaboration with Health, Wellness, and Occupational Studies (HWOS) to develop a 3+2 program for an undergraduate pathway to a MSOT degree. This will be implemented in the near future.

With the Center for Excellence in Aging and Health (CEAH), all MSOT Second Year Students participated in home safety assessments with over 20 Westbrook Housing Authority (WHA) residents. Students also had the opportunity to participate interprofessional in two wellness fairs with residents and during Vital Signs Day. Professors Jess Walton and Elise Ostensson have been championing these experiences.

UNE MSOT will be supporting our first international Level-II Fieldwork placement this year.
