## Definitions:

New: First term at UNE at that level. Returning: Continuing at UNE at the level.

FTE = Full time equivalent: This is equal to the headcount of full-time students plus the total credit hours earned by part-time students divided by the normal credit hour load for a full-time student. UNE uses the following definitions for full-time loads:

Undergraduate & Post-Bacc Pre-Health full-time load: 12 or more credit hours per semester.

Master's, Graduate Certificate, Post Master's, & Ed.D. full-time load: 6 or more credit hours per semester.

MSNA, MSPA, MOT, DPT, DO, PharmD & DMD students are full-time regardless of the number of credits.
