2. Persistence of the 2+4 program (Pre-Pharmacy) will be tracked for 3 years (150% of normal time to complete the undergraduate portion). Beginning with fall 2021 cohort, students will be awarded a bachelor's degree and do not need to be tracked separately.
3. Return rates include students who are still enrolled and students who graduated.
4. Students are considered in the starting cohort if they began their program in the summer or fall and were enrolled on October 15th.
5. In cases where a later return rate is higher than a previous year return rate for a single cohort it's because of leave of absences who return.
