The Rotating Internship is a flexible preliminary year structured to meet the individual needs of the trainee. The Osteopathic Interns are exposed to rotations in Internal Medicine, Critical Care, Emergency Medicine and Ambulatory Medicine and have the opportunity to use

six (6) electives based on their interests and needs. The electives include: Surgery, Primary Care Medicine, Osteopathic Manipulative Medicine, and Psychiatry as well as all medical and surgical subspecialties. Interested Interns have the option of participating in a weekly OMM Continuity Clinic.

We are committed to providing a complete Osteopathic education and offer an OMM Continuity Clinic for the Interns and Residents to see and treat their own patients. We also have an active OMM hospital consultation service and a monthly lecture/lab curriculum.
