and Social Justice Certificate**

While the Applied Arts and Social Justice Certificate (AASJ) requires the same number of credits as the traditional MSW, it does require some unique commitments. Please take a moment to review and initial each of the items below. You will not be granted a Certificate if you do not complete these requirements or their approved equivalent:

1. ____ I will attend AASJ meetings with other Certificate students.
2. ____ I will assist in the planning of at least one AASJ-sponsored event during my time as a student.
3. ____ I will fully participate in all campus-based AASJ events (barring conflicts with academic class time and field placement).
4. ____ I will complete at least three approved AASJ elective courses, one of which will be the self-titled course: Applied Arts and Social Justice.
5. ____ I will include an arts component into my Research course (with input from Research faculty and AASJ Coordinator).
6. ____ I will incorporate at least one ASSJ project within my fieldwork.
7. ____ In conjunction with the AASJ Coordinator, I will prepare a paper or presentation disseminating my research findings OR on a separate, approved arts project prior to graduating from the program.
