International students generally show proficiency by taking the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) or the International English Language Testing Systems (IELTS). To be accepted into a full-time University degree program, a minimum TOEFL score of 213 (computer test), 550 (paper test), or 79 (internet based) is required. Minimum passing score for the IELTS is an overall band of 6.0 or higher.
